Partnership of five Tyne & Wear LEAs - Shockwave - A three day dramatic emergency simulation for more than 120 students with associated CPD and resource pack



National Academy for Gifted and Talented Youth - a programme of outreach activities for G&T students delivered at centres around the country.



South Tyneside and Newcastle EiCs - Project Leonardo - a programme for all local schools, core days of activities for 100 students on Leonardo the artist, Leonardo the enigma, Leonardo the engineer and Leonardo the scientist and anatomist. Including web site development, teachers briefing, local media liaison, contact with students in Italy and possible visit to Florence.



North of Tyne Challenge Cup - Competitive activities over two days for teams of five students from fifteen schools. Activities include intellectual and physical challenges, an IT challenge and a general knowledge quiz.

Rochdale EiC - The Secret Formula - two day forensic science investigation at the Centre for Forensic science at University of Central Lancashire, including six experiments, police interviews and a body!

Oldham G&T cluster - Fun with Genes - Innovative nine day summer school with DNA workshops, experts in attendance telephone conferences with the creator of Dolly the sheep, an international clinical human geneticist and genetics counsellor, visits to interactive science centres, plus parents debate.



Hounslow EiC - Rainbow Island Disaster - an ecology disaster management game developed over two years and resulting in a days fun activity for students, teachers' CPD, videoed newscasts, student news bulletins, and a resource pack that is now in use in local schools.
